All IAEA members are invited to submit student work to be considered for the 2009 Youth Art Month Poster. The theme for the 2010 Youth Art Month Poster is “**Faces of Illinois.**” Explore students’ diverse backgrounds, interests, and personalities through any media. Participation in this campaign is only open to students of 2008 - 2009 IAEA members.

Please submit either originals or .jpeg images of your best student works via mail or email by **October 26, 2009**. Digital images of approximately 3 mega-pixels may be mailed on a CD or emailed.

Alternatively, you can drop off original artworks during the Fall IAEA Conference at the Registration Table from 7 - 11 a.m. and 2 - 3 p.m. on Friday, November 6, 2009. Students whose work is selected will appear on a poster in the Spring (sent to all IAEA members and state legislators), and they will also receive a copy of the poster and certificate of participation recognizing their achievement.

All original artworks mailed to me or turned in at the IAEA Conference can be picked up from **2 - 3 p.m. on Saturday November 7, 2009** at the Registration Table. Any original works not collected at the conference will be returned via mail.

Please complete the form below and attach it to the back of the artwork. If you are submitting this entry form digitally, save a copy of the form on your computer and send it to me as an attachment. When submitting digital files, make sure the title of the artwork matches the filename of the digital image. Also, please have the teacher and student sign their names in agreement and check the box indicating that a parent/ guardian has been informed that the work:

- will be appropriate for school and public display.
- may be used for reproduction in a statewide poster and/or promotion of IAEA and Youth Art Month.
- will be reproduced in reduced size format to accommodate the layout design of the poster if selected.
- may be retained by IAEA until the posters have been printed and distributed.
