

Illinois Art Education Association 2012 Youth Art Month Entry Form

All current IAEA members are invited to submit student artwork to be considered for the 2012 Youth Art Month Poster. This year's theme is "**Wilderness.**" Consider lessons that challenge your students to create artwork about the wonder and divine mysteries of earth's living ecosystem. It might be helpful to focus student direction to create images of animals, plants, wild scenery, or forces of nature. Elements of art to be considered could be texture and space. Also submit any artworks from current or past lessons that represent "Wilderness."

Please submit up to **6** original artworks. You may choose from two ways:

2. You may drop off original artworks during the Fall IAEA Conference at the Registration Table from on Friday, November 11th.

Students whose work is selected will appear on a poster in the Spring (sent to all IAEA members and state legislators), and they will also receive a copy of the poster and certificate of participation recognizing their achievement.

All original artworks mailed or turned in at the IAEA Conference can be picked up from **2 - 3 p.m. on Saturday, November 12th** at the Registration Table. Any original works not collected at the conference will be returned via mail.

Please complete the form below and attach it to the back of the artwork. If you are submitting this entry form digitally, click the "**SUBMIT**" button below and send the form as an attachment. When submitting digital files, match the title of the artwork with the filename of the digital image. Be sure to check the boxes below indicating that a parent/ guardian has been informed that the work:

- will be appropriate for school and public display.
- may be used for reproduction in a statewide poster and/or promotion of IAEA and Youth Art Month.
- will be reproduced in reduced size format to accommodate the layout design of the poster if selected.
- may be retained by IAEA until the posters have been printed and distributed.
