PATRIOTIC EAGLE

LESSON: Drawing

GRADE: 4

OBJECTIVES:

- 1. Create a work of art based on patriotic symbols and colors.
- 2. Draw a realistic eagle from a photograph.
- 3. Create a background using an imaginative arrangement of stars and stripes.
- 4. Add color with oil pastels. Color the eagle realistically, and use red, white, and blue in the background.

RESOURCES:

Posters, photos, and books of eagles

MATERIALS:

9" X 12" black construction paper eraser or white chalk for preliminary sketch oil pastels

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Demonstrate how to draw the eagle head. Consider size, placement, type of lines, length of line, direction of line, and how each line relates to previously drawn lines.
- 2. Draw carefully and accurately.
- 3. Add the rest of the body.
- 4. Color realistically with oil pastels.
- 5. Plan an imaginative background of stars and stripes. Use one or more stars. Stripes can be vertical, horizontal, diagonal, straight, wavy, radiating, etc.
- 6. Color the background with red, white, and blue oil pastels.
