Objectives:

1. Students will be introduced to artworks known as Amate bark paintings.

- 2. Students will draw a stylistic bird.
- 3. Students will paint a bird.
- 4. Students will use oil pastels to add details and design.

Tools:

Day 1 12"x18" brown construction paper Pencils Sharpie markers

<u>Day 2</u> Bright colors of tempera paints Paintbrushes

<u>Day 3</u> Oil pastels

Procedures:

<u>Day 1</u>

- 1. Introduce and discuss Amate paintings and how they are created. Inform students about Amate bark paper. Scan the artworks and point out areas like the bird and plants.
- 2. Demonstrate how to start their art:
 - Drawing with the class, draw a bird step by step. Also, work on drawing Amate style plants with the students.
 - Have the students outline their drawings with a Sharpie marker.

<u>Day 2</u>

- 1. Review Amate bark paintings. Focus on how the colors are used.
- 2. Demonstrate how to start their art:
- First, spend time talking about rules with a paintbrush and how to clean a paintbrush.
- Emphasize how to paint by painting in the lines and not mixing.
- 3. Let the students work to finish.

Day 3

- 1. Review Amate bark paintings. Look at the lines and designs the artists used to design the birds.
- 2. Demonstrate how to start their art:
- Show students how to use the oil pastels to outline their artworks.
- Use the oil pastels to draw designs.
- 3. Let the students work to finish.
