How to Share

1. Record Your Video: Use your phone, laptop, or camera to record a video

- Record horizontally if possible
- Find a quiet space
- Check your lighting. Use natural lighting when possible
- HAVE FUN! No pressure, this is meant to be enjoyable—and you look great!
- Keep it brief—aim for 2 minutes or less
- Record as many takes as you'd like—only give us your best one!

2. Trim: Use QuickTime, your camera roll, or other software to trim your video. Need help? Follow the attached guidelines.

3. Upload: Head over to ilaea.org/75th and upload your video.

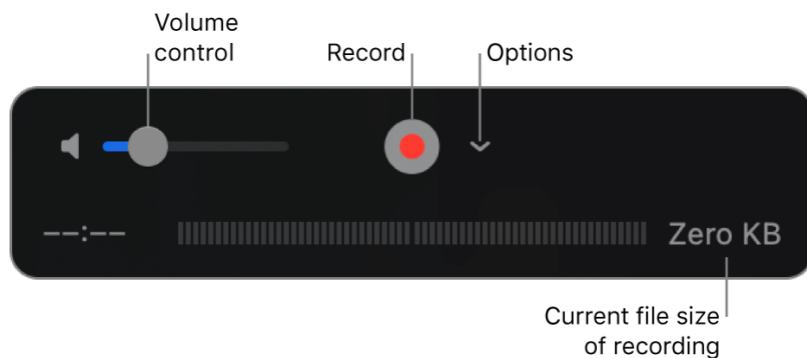
4. Share: Spread the word and invite a friend or colleague to share their story.

5. Celebrate: Join us for a special celebration at the Annual Conference on October 19-21

Record a movie in QuickTime Player on Mac

You can make a movie using the built-in camera on your Mac or using your iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch. When you make a movie, controls appear that allow you to start recording, control the volume, and choose recording options.






Use the built-in camera on your Mac

1. In the QuickTime Player app  on your Mac, choose File > New Movie Recording.

When the recording controls appear, you see a green light next to the built-in camera in your Mac.

 **Tip:** If your Mac doesn't have a built-in camera, you can connect an external camera.

2. Click the Options pop-up menu, then choose any of the following recording options:
 - *Camera:* Choose a camera if you have more than one camera available.
 - *Microphone:* Choose a microphone if you have more than one microphone available.
 - *Quality:* Choose the recording quality. Maximum-quality recordings produce uncompressed files, which can use large amounts of storage space.
3. Adjust the volume control to hear the audio you're recording.
4. Click the Record button  to start recording; click the Stop button  when you're done (or use the [Touch Bar](#)).



To pause recording, Option-click the Record button ; click it again to resume recording.
5. Choose File > Save to save and name the recording.

Trim a movie or clip in QuickTime Player on Mac

You can use the trimming bar in QuickTime Player to remove or “trim” parts of a movie or a movie clip.



Trim a movie

1. In the QuickTime Player app  on your Mac, open the movie you want to trim, then choose Edit > Trim.
2. Drag the yellow handles in the trimming bar. The area outside of the yellow handles is the area to be trimmed.
 **Tip:** To make more precise edits, click and hold a handle to see individual frames of the clip.
3. Click Trim.

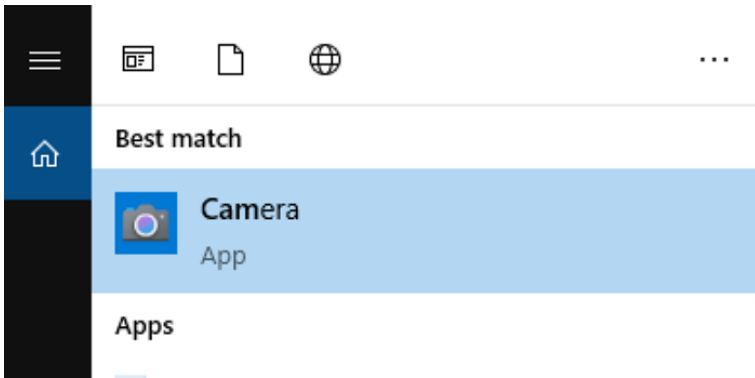

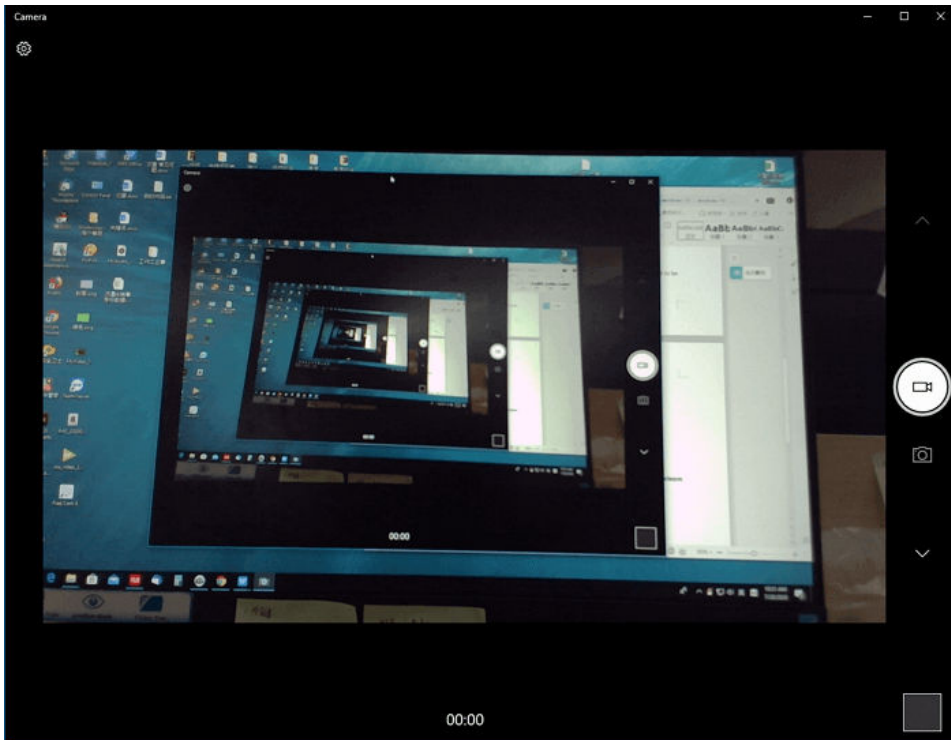
Guide to Recording and Editing Your Video – Windows

Record a movie using the Camera app on Windows 10

Step 1. Click Win + S on your keyboard to open the Search box, type in words, and find the Camera app.



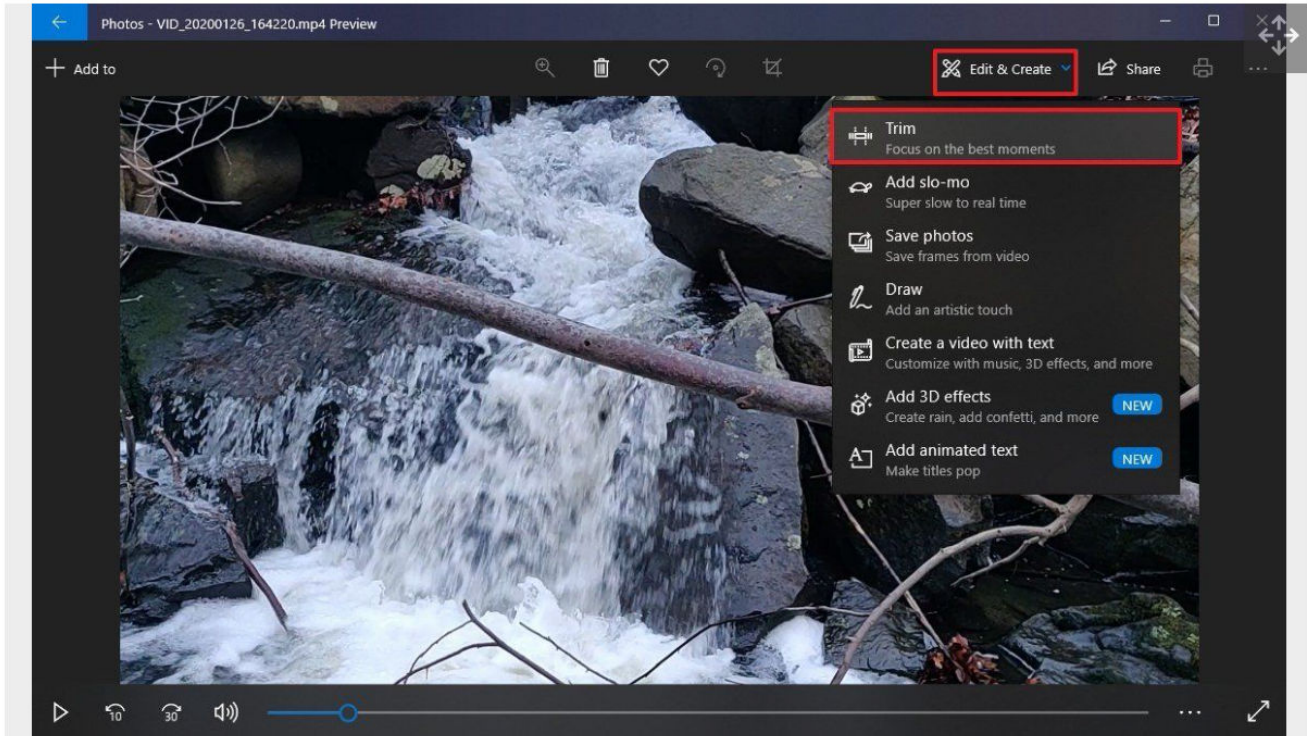
Step 2. Click or tap the Video button from the right side of the app's window to begin your webcam recording. Once you start recording a video, the Camera app displays a stopwatch on the bottom of the video, which tells you the time that has passed since you started recording.



Step 3. When you finish recording, click the stop button to end your recording, and then the recorded video with the webcam will save on your Windows PC.

Trim a movie using the Photos app on Windows 10

1. Open **Photos**.
2. Click the video you want to edit.
3. Click the **Edit & Create** button from the top-right corner, and select the **Trim** option.

4. Use the **white (right and left) pins** to select the part of the video you want to trim.
5. Use the **blue pin** to scrub the footage to make sure you're trimming the correct section.

6. Click the **Save a copy** button from the top-right corner.
