The IAEA is committed to helping arts educators bring artists into their learning environment to engage with students through artist talks, guest critique sessions, workshops, and virtual connections). **Apply now for the IAEA Artist Connection Honorarium.**

IAEA members are encouraged to apply for funds to pay artists who work with their students (or purchase an artwork from the artist as payment). Funding is based on the type and duration of engagement (e.g., artist talk vs. 2-day workshop). Priority is given to artists whose work aligns with IAEA's Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion core values (ilaea.org/edi).

- After we receive your completed application, our committee will review your proposal.
- Proposals are accepted on a rolling basis.

- Within 60 days of the completion of the project you will need to submit a brief summary report (250 words max) with 1-3 items of documentation (photos, student artworks, etc.). You must submit this report to be eligible to apply for funding in the future.
- Obtain institution approval for the engagement.
- Determine if funds will be distributed to the artist or institution.
